The Waimairi-iri Community of Learning is running a Waimairi-iri Experience Day for a number of our Year 5 to 7 learners. This is an excellent opportunity for students that demonstrate talents or have a high interest in the specific learning areas on offer.

The subject areas available to choose from will be **Mathematics, Digital Technology, The Arts, Science, Physical Education, Maori culture, Pasifika culture, Languages, Social Science and English**. Students will be able to immerse themselves in **two** areas of learning they are passionate about. Each activity will run for 95 minutes. They will experience learning and benefit from the specialist environments and teachers that Burnside High School has to offer the learners in our cluster.

Developing Information: The initial details we have are as follows:

- It will run between 9:30am -2:30pm
- Student/s will need to make their own way to and from Burnside on the day. Please drop off and pick up from outside the Aurora Centre (some schools may choose to come as a group).
- The students will participate in two activities over the day. The opportunity is for Year 5-7 students with strong talents/interests in these specific learning areas.
- If students have additional learning support/needs can you communicate these with us so we can accommodate them as required.
- Students do not need to wear their school uniform but are asked to dress appropriately for the subject area that they are participating in.
- Students are asked to bring their own lunch (a light morning tea will be provided).

More information will be sent Term 4 to finalise students in each learning area attending and details on the days schedule.
