NCEA Level 3 Requirements

80 credits

- 60 credits from Level 3 or above
- 20 are carried forward from Level 2

It is recommended that students aim for the highest possible achievement rather than just gaining credits.

University Entrance Requirements

- Must achieve NCEA Level 3
- Must have 14 credits in 3 subjects from the approved list (42 credits) and remaining credits from achievement or unit standards
- All subjects offered are on the approved list with the exception of Tikanga Māori and Tourism
- Must have UE Numeracy 10 credits Level 1 or higher
- Must have UE Literacy 5 reading credits and 5 writing credits at Level 2 or higher
