### **THE PROJECT**

We are offering ten individuals or groups of young people the opportunity to be filmed and recorded for OAR FM Dunedin's Youth Zone. Along with an interview, the footage of the performance will be edited together and available to listen to on OAR FM Dunedin, via podcast and to watch online.

The age range for this project is 12–18 years.

We will record the performances at OAR FM Dunedin studio in Moray Place. If the group is larger, we may be able to come to you! The default recording day will be on a Saturday at 11am, but this can be changed to suit your availability.
