STREET TALK Defensive Driving Course - Tauhara College Term Four 2021 FACILITATOR - David Bishara

The Street Talk Defensive Driving Course has been developed and approved by The New Zealand Transport Agency.

It focuses on: risk perception, risk management, self-reflection, decision making and goal setting, when driving.

The course consists of 8 x 1 hour classroom sessions, followed by a one-hour practical training session.

All sessions must be completed in order.

If a session is missed, then the participant will need to join another course from that session.

The practical session must be completed within **8 weeks** of finishing the last classroom session, following which a certificate will be issued.

For time reduction: on completion of this course, the certificate entitles persons **under 25 years of age** to reduce time on the Restricted Stage from 18 months to 1 year or if **over 25 years** to receive a time reduction from 6 months to 3 months.

Note: Learner Licence Holders will need to make sure they have access to a supervisor and vehicle for the practical driving homework assignments and will need to have had sufficient driving experience that they are almost ready to sit your Restricted Licence Test.

Note: Restricted and Full Licence holders will need to make sure they have access to a vehicle for the practical driving homework assignments.
