"Sweetie, you can't sit there all day and sulk," her mother said. "We'll have your party next weekend. I already called everyone and made all the arrangements."




Her mother sat down next to her. "The hurricane is ruining a lot. Look at that. Those people are trying to save their houses. Could you imagine if we lost our home?"

people even volunteer to help rebuild houses."






Sara nodded. "And maybe I could donate my birthday money. Those people are going to need it more than I do."




