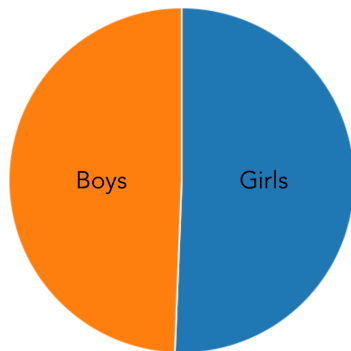


# Mingimingi Hautoa | Knights Stream School

## End of Year Data 2023

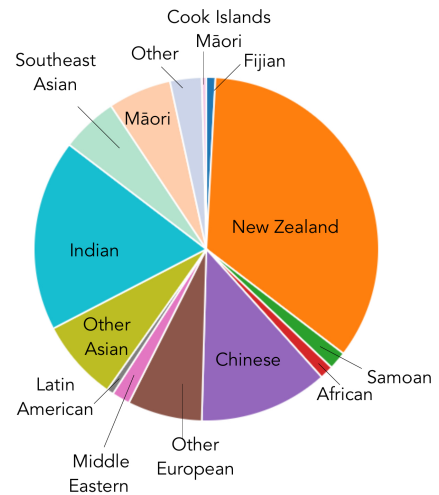


### Gender Composition



**468 students enrolled** at the end of 2023  
237 boys and 231 girls

### Ethnic Groups



**50%** of students are **ESOL**  
**70%** of our students are in **Year 0 - 4**

### Reading

**76% of students** are achieving within or beyond expectation for their age and stage.

### Writing

**83% of students** are achieving within or beyond expectation for their age and stage.

### Maths

**92% of students** are achieving within or beyond expectation for their age and stage.

At Knights Stream School | Mingimingi Hautoa reporting student achievement is an important part of our teaching and learning process. Reporting on individual progress and achievement is carried out formally twice a year. We also collect and analyse school-wide assessment data throughout the year. We use this information as the basis for changes to policies or programmes, or changes to our teaching practices, and to implement targeted interventions, as well as for reporting to the Board, whānau and the Ministry of Education.

Student data helps to inform the strategic direction of Knights Stream School | Mingimingi Hautoa. Assessment information is also used to compare the relative achievement of different groups of students or to compare the achievement of our students against the New Zealand Curriculum levels. Progress and achievement is tracked using our student management system *Hero*. Staff have a clear understanding of students progress and achievement and their next steps for learning.
