The Rights and Responsibilities of a Parkview Pārua student/ākonga

- Take care in looking after and using school devices
- Keep passwords to Parkview's network secure and private
- Only use devices and Google accounts for learning, as directed by the teacher or in association with assigned work
- Use devices or the network appropriately
- Immediately comply with all teacher requests
- Allow teachers to inspect content on any device

Student Declaration

- I understand that these guidelines for responsible use are to be followed when using any technology whilst at school or whilst on any school activity. I am aware that this may include the use of a device that the school does not own.
- I understand that if I breach the **Student Right and Responsibilities** agreement, I may lose access to school ICT services including the use of the internet on school owned devices.

Parents/Caregivers

- I have read the **Student Right and Responsibilities Information** and I understand that there may be severe consequences if the rules are broken. I have gone over the information with my child and explained its importance. I also understand that theft or damage to equipment could result in the home receiving a bill for the cost of replacement parts or repairs.
- I understand that while the school will do its best to restrict student access to offensive, dangerous or illegal material on the internet or through email, it is the responsibility of my child to have no involvement in such material.
