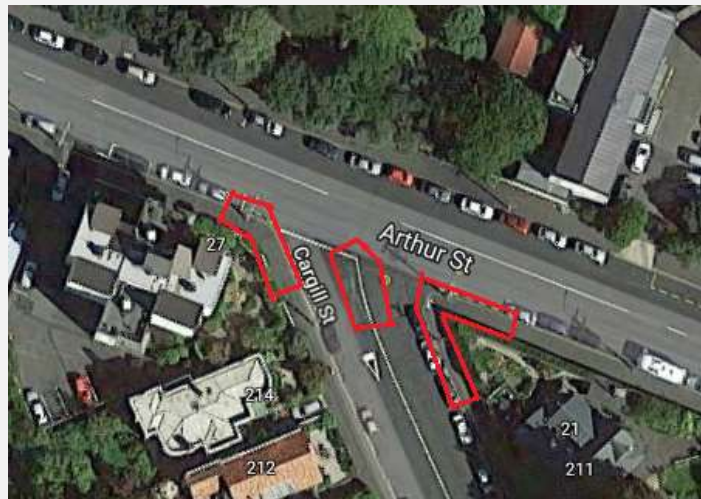
#### **What we are doing:**

We will be installing new drainage, construction pedestrian refuge island, digging out the existing kerb, and replacing them in different positions. The narrowing of the road will encourage drivers to slow down around the school, also giving school children safe areas to cross.

#### **Traffic Impact:**

There will be a significant amount of cones, fences and signs used during construction to allow our workers to carry out their tasks safely and efficiently. All houses/roads will be accessible at all times however please obey the signs and instructions of workers on site.

There will be no entry into Cargill St from Arthur St. Resident access will be maintained via the detour during the works.

There will be increased noise, dust and vibration levels during construction.



Works will have no planned impact on current power, water telecommunication or gas services. However, please be prepared for an unexpected service cut off.



All works are subject to favorable weather and on-site construction conditions. Please note that inclement weather may extend the completion date.



Your rubbish and recycling will not change. Please put your bins out at the normal time and our crew will move and return them if needed.



Safety is our number one priority, but safety is your responsibility too. Stay clear and stay alert – keep children and pets at a safe distance from the work site.



Our standard work hours are Monday to Friday between the hours of 7:00am and 7:00pm, however we may need to work at night or on a Saturday to complete the work. We will notify you before we do this.
