- You will have a pivotal role in attracting new players to the club, by co-ordinating visits to local schools with SKYCITY Stampede players and ice hockey playing students.
- Develop a player pathway to help with player retention and communicate that to the Junior Club players and families.
- Work with Alexandra Ice Hockey Club to have “game nights” for our younger players.
- Plan and deliver FUN, Well run, structured practices to up their skills with games.
- Ensure age group practices have both a skills based and teams coaching “hockey sense” component.

- Work with Junior Club Assistant Coach to deliver practices and provide effective coaching at games and practices.
- Take an active part in the Leslie Brothers online coaching coach and mentoring being provided by QIHC for professional development of head coach.
- Communicate practice plans to parent and player coaches before each club practice to minimise down time on the ice explaining practice plan.
- Establish effective communication with parents via “club hub” and emails out to age groups at least twice per term as to focus and direction of practices.
- Willing to undertake mid and end of season performance reviews.
- Keep open dialogue with President and executive committee to ensure needs of players are being met.
- Attend and verbally report to QIHC Committee meetings.
- Plan and deliver all scheduled practice times for:
 - Kiwi - beginners
 - U12 Atoms
 - U15 Bantams
 - U18 Midgets
 - Wakatipu Highschool teams
- Attendance at all Weekend Tournaments / Trainings
 - Southern Ice Hockey Rounds
 - Representative U18 and U15 Junior Stampede Hockey Tournaments
 - Representative U18 and U15 Junior Stampede Hockey Trainings
