What will the Puhoto STEMM Academy deliver for our Year 10 rangatahi/students?

- They will be running a Wero Pūrau, which is a programme that draws inspiration from Māori pūrākau and weaves traditional narratives into engaging STEMM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Mathematics, Mātauranga Māori) challenges for our Year 10 rangatahi.
- Through these hands-on wero/challenges, rangatahi will forge a natural connection between themselves and the world of science.
- This kaupapa reiterates essentially that Aotearoa has a deep whakapapa of brilliant scientists, and that science is an integral part of their very DNA.
- Wero Pūrau invites us all to embrace this legacy and celebrate the enduring bond between our heritage and the world of scientific discovery.

How will the day be organised?

- You will be working with other Year 10 students from your lwi/house.
- You will be doing 4 different wero/challenges
- Meet in the big gym before 9am on Friday 24th November.
- Wear your school uniform or iwi coloured clothes (IE only clothing that is the colour of your iwi will be accepted) with enclosed shoes (these are for safety reasons).
- School lunches will be provided, but bring any snacks you want and your drink bottle.
- Bring your positive attitude and problem solving skills as there may be prizes at the end of the day.
