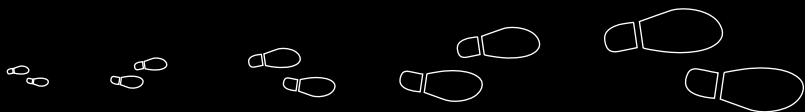

FOOD, FIBRE AND AGRICULTURE TECHNOLOGY



Canterbury is New Zealand's largest agricultural region, contributing 20% to the national agricultural GDP. The region produces meat and dairy products, plant-based products, seafood and wine for both domestic and international consumers. The agricultural sector supports 19,000 people employed in agriculture, fishing and forestry and a further 14,400 in agricultural production processing. Christchurch is the logistical hub and provider of manufacturing, technology and professional services into the agricultural sector.

Once you have an offer of place or letter of acceptance from your education provider, and you've paid the required fees, you can apply for your student visa.
