### **WAIAU PIG HUNT**

We are pleased to announce that under the current Alert Level 2 settings, the WAIAU PIG HUNT will still take place, albeit in a slightly different format...

We have made the following modifications to ensure that we meet the public health requirements set out by the New Zealand Government:

- Stay Home if you are feeling unwell.
- Mask Wearing —all participants are encouraged to wear a face mask/covering when they are in the rugby grounds. All staff and volunteers will be required to wear a face mask/covering for the duration of the event.
- **Weigh-In Process** Please remain in your vehicle while waiting for your turn to weigh in. When asked, unload your catch in the specified area and move to the front of your vehicle while weighing and judging takes place.

After weighing, reload your catch into your vehicle - we will not have animals on display this year.

The weigh in areas will be separated from the bar area.

- Spot Prizes All are welcome to come and collect your spot prize on the day. There will be a drive-by contactless spot prize collection site, just follow directions.
- Pig and Hare Carrying Competitions These activities will NOT be held.

- **Kids weigh in** Due to restrictions on numbers, children may weigh in their catches but will be expected to leave once completed. We will contact the winners.
- Licenced Bar As per Alert Level 2 restrictions, bar numbers will be limited to 100 people 18+. Once we have reached capacity, all others will be required to vacate the rugby grounds promptly after weighing in their catch. Attendees are asked to follow Covid 19 requirements for attending social functions including: sign in using the Covid 19 app; wear a face covering where possible these can be taken off to eat and drink; attendees must be seated to eat or drink; attendees must stay 1 metre away from each other
- **Prizegiving** prizegiving will be live streamed, keep an eye out for this on Facebook. There will be contactless collection available for prize winners at the bar area and collection or delivery of prizes will be arranged to winners not present. Cash prizes will be paid via electronic banking. Please ensure we have the correct email address so we can arrange this with you via email.

Between now and the event day, things may change and we will continue to keep you up to date.

Should Canterbury return to **Alert Level 1** before Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> October then the event will proceed as normal.

# Refuse and Recycling Culverden and Waiau

Due to the public holiday on Monday 25th October, the Culverden and Waiau transfer stations will be closed.

There are no changes to the arrangements for refuse and recycling in Waiau, Rotherham and Culverden with collections running as normal on a Thursday.

### Please remember the following:

- Only Hurunui Council bags will be collected.
- These can be purchased from Culverden Four Square, Rotherham Store, Waiau Hardware and Amuri Library.
- Bags must be securely tied and at the kerbside by 8am as collection times may vary to normal; the crew will not return to collect bags which are placed out late.
- · Refuse bags must not exceed 15kg.
- Bags split prior to the crew's arrival and non-official bags will not be collected.
- Bundles of cardboard will not be collected but can be recycled via the transfer station.

The following are accepted via Councils recycling bags, providing they are clean, free from food waste and loose (papers should not be tied in bundles).

- Newspapers, magazines, office paper and telephone directories.
- Cardboard, greetings cards, junk mail, envelopes, and egg boxes.
- Food, drink, and pet food cans.
- Rigid plastic bottles and small containers, types 1, 2 and 5 only with lids removed.




