

**Somerfield Te Kura Wairepo**  
**DRAFT Enrolment Scheme Amendment**  
**Effective January 2021**

The guidelines for development and operation of enrolment schemes are issued under section 11G (3) of the Education Act 1989 for the purpose of describing the basis on which the Secretary's powers in relation to enrolment schemes will be exercised.

**Home Zone**

**All students who live within the home zone described below (and shown on the attached map) shall be eligible to enroll at the school.**

**Starting from the intersection of Frankleigh Street and Barrington Street,**

- **North along the East side only of Barrington Street to Athelson Street**
- **North East along Athelson Street to Simeon Street**
- **North West along Simeon Street to Meadowville Avenue**
- **North East along Meadowville Avenue to Cheviot Street**
- **North East along Cheviot Street to Selwyn Street**
- **South East along Selwyn Street to Milton Street**
- **North East along Milton Street to Dominion Avenue**
- **North West, then North East along Dominion Avenue to Strickland Street**
- **South East along Strickland Street to Milton Street**
- **North East along Milton Street to Colombo Street**
- **South along the West side of Colombo Street to Ashgrove Terrace**
- **South West along Ashgrove Terrace to Fairview Street**  
**including Ashgrove Terrace address between Fairview Street and Cashmere View Street**
- **North West along Fairview Street to Rose Street**
- **North East along Rose Street to Beechworth Avenue**
- **North West along Beechworth Avenue to Stanbury Avenue**
- **North East along Stanbury Avenue to Barrington Street**  
**(including Stanbury Avenue Address down to 39 (odd) and 46 (even))**
- **North West along Barrington Street to Frankleigh Street**  
**including Conway Street addresses down to 47a (odd) and 48 (even) and Nina Lane**  
**including Roberta Drive addresses down to 41 (odd) and 42 (even)**  
**including even numbered addresses on Frankleigh Street 34, 34A and above.**

Addresses on both sides of boundary roads are considered in-zone unless specified otherwise.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date that will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places that can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

## Special Programmes

This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a Special programme approved by the Secretary.

## Out of Zone Enrolments

Each year the Board of Trustees will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The Board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolments will be processed in the following order of priority:

- **First priority** is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary for Education.
- **Second priority** must be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
- **Third priority** must be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
- **Fourth priority** must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
- **Fifth priority** must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
- **Sixth priority** must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, fifth or sixth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by ballot conducted in accordance with instructions by the Secretary, under Section 11G (1) on the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
