## TE AROHA COLLEGE PRACTICE & DERIVED GRADE EXAMS ADVICE TO EXAM CANDIDATES

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### ***The night before your exam***

1. Pack your bag with all the stationery you need (pens, ruler, calculator ... water bottle).
2. Prepare your uniform.
3. Set your alarm.
4. Read over your notes BUT DO NOT stay up all night studying.
5. Charge your device.

### ***On the Day***

6. Put your device and charger in your bag.
7. Fill your drink bottle and put it in your bag.
8. Eat something.
9. Be outside the Hall at the right time.
10. If you are sick, phone school.

### ***After the Exam***

11. Stay at school if you want to study or work on internals.
12. Collect lunch from the canteen.
