# **Details**

This work will occur between 7am and 6pm, starting Tuesday 22 April and ending Sunday 27 April 2025. The work will take place along Averill Street, between Chrystal Street and North Parade.

Work is planned as follows (weather dependent):

- Construction of two new speed humps outside Pareawa Banks Avenue School – Tuesday 22 April to Thursday 24 April 2025.
- New road and cycleway green painting, line marking to mark the boundaries of the cycleway, and road and cycleway symbols between Chrystal Street and North Parade – Thursday 24 April to Sunday 27 April 2025.

The works schedule has been planned to minimise the disruption for the school and residents.
