\*Students who learn an instrument may be asked to audition for the School Orchestra. Our orchestra conductor will listen to students play when they can play at least a scale. There is a possibility students will be able to join the orchestra throughout the year as well.

All of these groups practise once a week, and **perform** at school and at different events throughout the year. Avonhead School pays for tutors to take these groups, so there is no cost involved to you. A year long **commitment** is expected, including evening performances. You will be asked to acknowledge that you understand this commitment when you register your child for a music group.
