Principal's Report

Presented to the Board and read prior to the meeting.

- Advertising for the tagged teaching positions has been in the Gazette since the beginning of August. We have received
 4–5 applications from NZ tagged teachers.
- Release for Room 1 Sam Mathewson taking sport on Tuesday afternoon.

- Catholic Review Office here on 25-26 August looking at school wide practices and teaching of religious education.
 Brenna provided an overview of what the review process will look like. Survey for Board members to complete sending to previous Board members also. Meeting with students and teachers, Charlotte and David.
- Prayer Conference in Temuka 187 attended from community.
- Wonderful Mary MacKillop Day event, though it was wet.
- Possibly will only have 5 teaching positions for 2026 will know sometime in October.

- Three students went to Opihi College to Chess competition and had a great day.

Self Review

- Overview of Technology Year 7&8 at Opihi College. Brenna to forward information.
- Mid Term Data Data this year from new curriculum, last year from old curriculum so some disparity with curriculum objectives changing. Same for reading, writing an area of concern but end of last year working At 74% will look better by end of year.

Reading – Year 0 75% Within, Year 1 43% within, Yr 2 reading 67% within, boys working at 50% expected level and girls 71%. Yr 3 86% within, Yr 4 reading of concern – 53% within but sitting on cusp with having trouble with comprehension, working hard on. Yr 5 tracking well with 92% within - boys 100% of boys within. Yr 6 64% within. Yr 7 62% within (5 out of 8 students). Yr 8 72% working within and 60% boys working within and girls 87.5%. Writing – Yr 0 50%, Yr 2 64%, Yr 3 43%, Yr 4 43%, Yr 5 70%, Yr 6 64%, Yr 7 25%, Yr 8 56%. New curriculum not using the Beyond section. Writing the area to look at next year and by the end of the year will have a clearer idea. Will do some work around moderation with new curriculum with more guidance by then. Will receive an electronic test for students across NZ, teachers still have overall judgement.
