Temporary Road Closure

We're improving the road surface in Greenhithe

Kia ora,

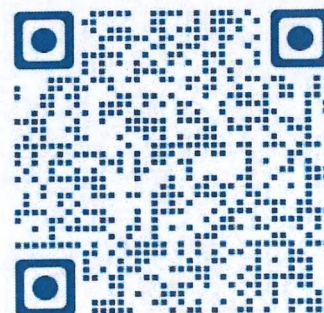
Our role is to ensure that people can move around the city easily and safely. We carry out regular maintenance and repair work on the network so they can do this in an easy and efficient manner.

We have identified that road surface on Kyle Road needs to be replaced.

Chip seal operations will be conducted as follows:

- One day prior to re-surfacing works: No parking signs set out, letter drop on vehicles
- On the day of operations: Spraying of bitumen and spreading of chip
- 48hrs post sealing: Sweeping of loose chip, road marking, uplifting no-parking signage
- 6 weeks post sealing: second sweep of loose chip

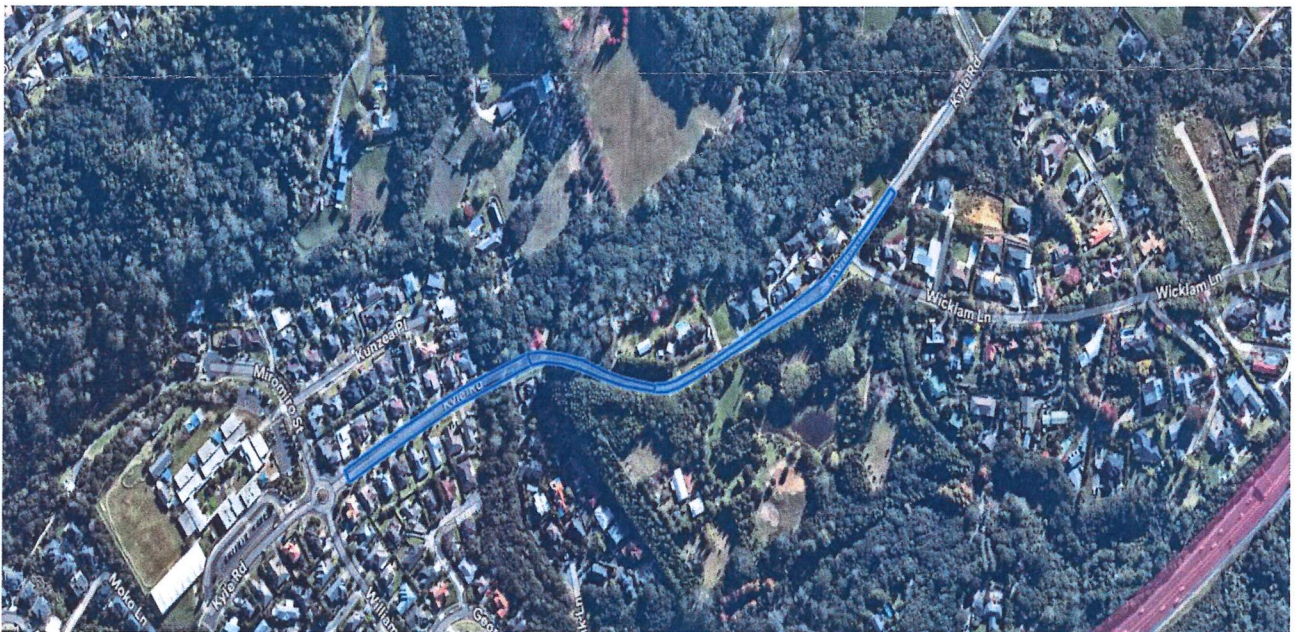
How this affects you

- We'll do our best to start the work on time. Factors such as wet weather could mean a delayed start. If the delay is significant, we'll notify you.

Traffic Management and detours

- We will use a mix of temporary traffic signs (like stop/go signs) and traffic lights, and a lower speed limit. We do this to keep traffic moving and keep people who use the roads and footpaths safe. Traffic controllers will help to manage vehicle access. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.
- You'll need to reduce your speed when you're driving through the area. Please follow all signs, light signals and traffic directions.
- On-street parking will be limited while we carry out the work. You may need to either park on your property or on a side road and walk to your property.
