Amuri Community Trust News

The ownership of the Waiau and Culverden Plunket Rooms was transferred to the Amuri Community Trust in 2022 after a long battle with NZ Plunket. The ownership transfer came with the understanding that it was the Amuri Community Trust's ultimate responsibility to ensure these community assets can pay for themselves.

Despite our best attempts to see the Plunket Rooms fully utilised this has not been achieved and the decision has been made to sell the Waiau Plunket Rooms; the Culverden Plunket Rooms are currently leased to NZ Plunket.

The Amuri Community Trust was set up to assist both individuals and groups in the community. The ACT trustees believe that the costs associated with the Waiau Plunket Rooms are better used elsewhere. It is the intention of the ACT trustees to use the income released to further benefit the community's needs.

The Waiau Plunket Rooms will be listed for sale through an independent real estate agent in due course.
