Refuse and Recycling Culverden, Rotherham, Waiau, Hawarden and Waikari

Due to Waitangi Day, for one week only, refuse and recycling will be collected one day later than normal - on Friday 7 February.

Please remember the following:

- Only Hurunui Council bags will be collected. In Hanmer Springs these can be purchased from the library, Super Liquor, Log Cabin, and the Service Station.
- Bags must be securely tied and at the kerbside by 8am as collection times may vary to normal; the crew will not return to collect bags that are placed out late.
- Refuse bags must not exceed 15kg.
- Bags split prior to the crew's arrival and non-official bags will not be collected.
- Bundles of cardboard will not be collected but can be recycled via the transfer station.

What is accepted via the recycling collections?

The following are accepted, providing they are clean, free from food waste and loose (papers should not be tied in bundles) in a Council recycling bag.

- Newspapers, magazines, office paper and telephone directories.
- Cardboard, greeting cards, junk mail, envelopes, and egg boxes.
- Food, drink, and pet food cans.
- Rigid plastic bottles and small containers, types 1, 2 and 5 only with lids removed.

All Hurunui Council transfer stations are closed on Thursday 6 February.

Amberley transfer station will open from 10am to 4pm on Tuesday 4 February.



Help us find the invader, great willowherb

When you're out and about exploring your local wetlands, lakes and rivers this summer, keep your eyes peeled for the invasive plant, great willowherb.

This aggressive invader quickly forms dense infestations in wetlands and other vulnerable waterways, crowding out native plants.

It has distinctive pink flowers with notched petals. Plants can grow up to 2 metres tall with leaves that are slightly hairy with a toothed edge attached directly to the stem.




