Worth speaking up for

Christ Church Cathedral is our centrepiece civic space and a building of national significance.

It is also an economic driver for Cathedral Square and the city as it nears the end of its celebrated rebuild.

The Re:Opening plan will see the Cathedral reopen in stages (just as it was built in 1881). A fully functional 700-seat Cathedral, including the Tower, the west wall with our iconic Rose Window, and the Nave. If we start now, we can reopen the doors in 2030.
