From here, you will be able to submit attendance, view student information, book school interviews and receive the latest information from the school.

If, for some reason, you cannot log in to Hero, it could be that the email you provided the school with is incorrect or different. Please contact the school to help troubleshoot.

If your child is absent from school please send through an absentee message via Hero, or contact the school office on 03 385 2229 and provide us with an explanation for the absence. If your child is absent with no explanation you will receive a text message and a follow up phone call from the school admin team.

School Uniform/Stationery Lists for 2025 can be found on our website. All stationery required for 2025 can be purchased at any stationery outlet store, although Qizzle have a full stationery pack that can be ordered and delivered to your address using this link, <a href="Schoolpacks.co.nz">Schoolpacks.co.nz</a>. Students will need to have all required stationery on their first day of school. Please make sure your child is in the correct school uniform for the beginning of Term One 2025, our school uniform can be purchased from Mainland Uniforms in Peterborough Street or ordered online.

The school newsletter is sent out fortnightly via email. If you are not receiving these please contact the office as your email address we have is probably incorrect. Please notify the office with any changes to phone numbers, contacts and email addresses.

Cell phones are to be handed in daily to the class teacher. The phones are locked away for safekeeping in the school office during the school day and handed back at the end of each day. No responsibility is taken by the school for stolen or lost cell phones. Any child caught using a cell phone during the day will have it removed and parents will be contacted.

Our school receives healthy school lunches. If a special dietary requirement is needed and you did not stipulate this on your enrolment form please let the school office know as soon as possible.

Senior management are in the process of arranging class placements for 2025. We will email your child's class and teacher at the end of this term.
