Submission Criteria

Eligibility:

- All entries must be the **original work** of the submitting artist.
- Each artwork must be created by the artist listed on the submission and must not infringe upon any copyrights or intellectual property rights.
- The work must be the artist's own design and execution reproductions or copies of other artists' work are not eligible.
- Works submitted must be suitable for public exhibition.



Liability Disclaimer:

- While all reasonable care will be taken with submitted artworks,
 Harcourts Geraldine, the Arts & Plants Committee, Stonebridge, and all associated volunteers and organisers accept no liability for any loss,
 theft, or damage to artworks or materials at any stage of the exhibition process, including delivery, display, or return.
- Insurance of artwork, if desired, is the sole responsibility of the artist.
- By submitting an entry, the artist agrees to these terms and confirms that the work is their own original creation.

All media:

- Paintings, Drawings, Sculpture, Ceramics, Glass, Fibre Art, Wood, Metal or Mixed Media.
- No work is to be removed from the gallery by the exhibitor before the exhibition closes.
- Full size artwork must not exceed one metre by one metre.

Insurance is the artist's responsibility, and all work submitted is at the artist's own risk.

Sales

- All work must be for sale, with a minimum price of \$100.
- Commission on sales is 25%.
- Payment to artists will be made within 6 weeks of the Exhibition closing.



Copyright

While copyright remains with the artist, the organisers reserve the right to photograph and reproduce images of selected works for publicity relating to the Exhibition. The artist will be contacted for permission to use images for any other purpose.

Presentation

- Paintings should be dry.
- Framing should be of good quality and without damage.
- The edges of unframed paintings should be clean and tidy.
- All works to be professionally finished and ready to hang with an appropriate hanging system.
- Framing and matt boards must be clean and presentable. The standard practice is not to sign on the matt board but on the artwork itself.

The Selection of work and inclusion in the exhibition is at the discretion of the selectors and their decision is final. No further discussion will be entered into.

Categories

1. Supreme Award – Best Overall Artwork

Prize: \$1,000
 Selected as the most outstanding artwork across all categories.

2. Excellence in Painting & Drawing

First Prize: \$500Runner-Up: \$250



3. Excellence in Sculpture (including metalwork)

First Prize: \$500Runner-Up: \$250

4. Excellence in Mixed Media / Printmaking / Textiles

First Prize: \$500Runner-Up: \$250

5. Emerging Artist Award (any medium)

Prize: \$300
 For artists under 25 years of age or within their first 3 years of practice.

6. People's Choice Award

 Prize: \$250
 Voted by the public during the exhibition. Announced after the close of the show.

7. Judge's Commendation Awards (x2)

Prize: \$125 each
 Acknowledges merit outside of the main categories.
