	LOW	•	The attendance of each child is checked by the classroom teacher; before leaving the school, arriving at the location - classes that have children travelling in different buses, leaving the location - buddy check and arriving back at school - classes that have children travelling in different buses.  Children are advised before leaving the school that they are only allowed to go to the toilet if their teacher has given them permission.  Children going to the toilet must report to their teacher on their return.  Children go to the toilet in pairs.  All children travel to and from school on the bus.  The Town Hall toilets are checked by a teacher at the start of rehearsal. All exit doors are also checked to ensure that strangers can not enter the Town Hall complex from a back door.  A teacher will be posted to monitor who enters the

Weather	LOW	•	If it rains, the bus will pull into the loading bay in front of the school, one bus at a time so the children can enter the Town Hall without delay.  Children will take their school jackets.	
Trip on sidewalk, paths	LOW	•	Teachers and children are alert and watch sidewalks or paths carefully when walking to the bus and from the bus.  The bus driver will drop the roup off on the side where they should be in order to avoid crossing the road.	
Hit by a car / bus.	Mode rate	•	Teachers walk at the front and end of the group and check when getting off and on the bus appropriately. Teachers will ensure that children stay away from the road.  Teachers will ensure that children wait on the curb 1m away from an approaching bus.  Teachers will ensure that the children wait until the bus is completely stationary before approaching the bus.	
Environment		•	Teachers monitor children in the auditorium at all times. Children are prohibited from leaning over the bannaster. Teachers will call children back from the bannaster if they are too close.	
Vulnerable Children Act	LOW	•	Children will stay with the class at all times. Teachers will supervise their class and the group they are travelling with. Two adults will travel on each bus.	Travelling plan

Medical	LOW	•	In the event of a minor injury Teachers apply first aid.  Teachers ensure that all asthmatics take their inhaler.  Inhaler is carried by the child.  Teachers have a list of children's medical needs.  The class teacher confirms they have the medication.	Asthma Inhalers Medication

SERIOUS INJURY	Mode rate		A teacher must remain with their class. If possible a teacher will accompany the child to hospital in the ambulance.  The school is called. The school is responsible for contacting the parents of the injured child.	First aid kit

CIVIL Extre me	<ul> <li>If a civil emergency strikes in transit, the bus immediately stops. All children remain on the bus until otherwise directed by the teachers responsible for the bus. Once the event has passed and if the roads are clear, the bus returns the children back to school. If the bus is unable to proceed, the teacher-in-charge finds safe accommodation for the children and immediately contacts the school for further instructions. If children have been injured they are moved to a safe place, teachers provide first aid and the emergency services are called.</li> <li>If a civil emergency strikes while inside the Town Hall, everybody will 'drop, cover, hold'. Then the teacher will direct everybody to vacate the hall and assemble in the carpark when appropriate. Teachers will check that everybody is accounted for and will administer first aid if needed. We will return to the Town Hall if it is safe. If it is not safe to return, the school will organise alternative accommodation for the children and communicate next steps to parents.</li> </ul>	Cell phone Contact details First aid
