Safe Alternatives to Lighting a Candle in Church



Why Alternatives?

In some church settings, open flames cannot be left unattended. These alternatives offer safe and meaningful ways to symbolise prayer, remembrance, and the presence of Christ, without risk.



LED Candle Options

- Battery-powered tealights placed on a prayer table; people may switch one on.
- Rechargeable LED pillar candles can be set on timers for daily use.
- Electronic votive stand visitors press a button to light an LED candle.

Symbolic Prayer Alternatives

- Place a pebble, shell, or coloured bead in a bowl a visible prayer offering.
- Paper 'flame' prayer slips write intentions and place in a display bowl or board.
- LED lantern left glowing as a continuous prayer symbol.
- Digital candle image displayed on screen or kiosk in prayer corner.

Suggested Sign/Liturgy Wording

"You are invited to switch on a candle (or place a stone) as a sign of your prayer.

These lights continue before God even when we are not here, reminding us that our prayers dwell in God's presence."
