

Sourced from: For the skirt part of my outfit I used donations that were received by the textiles department at school, where we were donated tubs full of faulty jeans that weren't allowed to be sold in store anymore. For the top half of my garment, all of my tartan was cut from my teachers fabric scraps in her class, that's why I decided to do small sections of each material so I was able to make up a whole garment.




