Revised tsunami evacuation zones released for Hurunui District

Hurunui District Council is releasing revised tsunami evacuation zones on Friday 14 February 2025.

The revised evacuation zones are based on new modelling by GNS Science and show areas of Hurunui's coastline that could be flooded in a worse-case tsunami scenario.

The new modelling sees some change for Hurunui's tsunami evacuation zones, affecting properties located between Waipara Rocks (north of the Waipara River mouth) and Claverley.

There are no changes for the coastal area south of the Waipara Rocks, including Leithfield, Leithfield Beach and Amberley Beach.

The revised tsunami evacuation zones will be uploaded on 14 February 2025, and will be available to view online at www.cdemcanterbury.govt.nz/hazards/tsunamis

If you are inside the tsunami evacuation zones and you feel a long (more than one minute) or strong (hard to stand up) earthquake you should leave the tsunami evacuation zones as soon as the shaking stops. Move uphill or inland so that you are no longer in the tsunami evacuation zones. Don't wait for an official warning. A tsunami could arrive within minutes. Be mindful of landslides/rockfalls in hilly areas.

Agrecovery is trialling a free drop-off service for your agri-plastic in the Hurunui District between 19 February and 13 March 2025.

- Plastic mulch
- Small seed, feed or fertiliser bags
- Irrigation pipes
- ½ and 1 tonne bulk bags (FBCS)

- Bale wrap and silage pit covers

ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

Proper presentation of plastic is essential. Please ensure you follow the criteria below or your plastic may be rejected. Agrecovery reserves the right to decline any plastic that is deemed to be not acceptable.

✓ PREP YOUR PLASTIC:

- Ensure all plastic is clean and free of contaminants and excessive dirt.
- Plastic must be separated into product types.
- Where possible, separate outer and inner wrap linings.
- Bale wrap to be delivered loose or in Plasback or Agrecovery liners. (Please see website for details on where to get liners)
- Silage pit covers tied up as manageable 2 metre bundles.
- Irrigation pipe rolled into coils or cut into 1 metre lengths.

✗ PLEASE NO:

- Household, construction or industry plastic or rubbish
- Stones and excessive dirt
- Tape (sealing bale wrap tears)
- Metal (wire etc.)
- Effluent pipe
- Netting

✗ WHAT IS CONTAMINATION?

Contamination in recycling such as dirt, stones, wire, excessive residues, and mixed plastics, can pose health and safety risks, damage processing equipment and prevent materials from being accepted for recycling.

ABOUT THE PILOT:

Agrecovery operates the only nationwide agricultural recycling programme accredited by the Minister for the Environment. This pilot is testing the design and implementation of the Green-farms Product Stewardship Scheme - a nationwide regulated scheme for the recovery of all farm plastics. 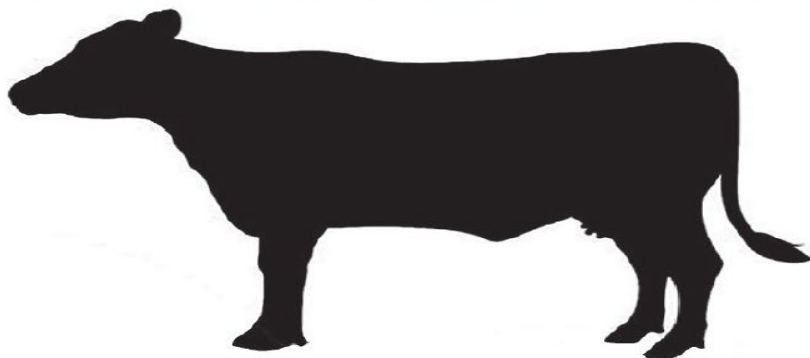
