BOOKS BORROWED

Over 57,000 books borrowed. 8,700 non-fiction; 13,000 picture; 10,000 fiction; 12,000 graphic novels and 2,000 early readers; 241 eplatform loans (53% ebooks and 46% audio books).

NEW BOOKS & NATIONAL LIBRARY BOOKS

1,526 new books added to the collection.
22 new Te Ao Māori; 23 Pasifika books.
2 new class novel sets; 12,000 books in total in our collection; 3000 ebooks and audio books on the eplatform.
2200 National Library books borrowed to support teaching and reading for pleasure. 56 lost books





SUMMER READING

Over 220 tamariki are signed up to borrow books for the summer holidays so far. This helps to support literacy and avoid the summer slide in reading achievement gained during the year.

HELLS PIZZA WHEELS

113 Kaurilands tamariki completed their Hell's Pizza reading challenge. 7 books were read with a question answered or a book review. Over 700 more books read and 113 Hell's pizza's!





SCHOLASTIC REWARDS

The library raised over \$5,000 worth of rewards through Scholastic Fair and Bookclub sales. This will be spent on new class novel sets, literacy resources and books for the library.

LIBRARY SEARCHES & RESERVES

Over 12,000 library catalogue searches. This helps to improve their digital literacy skills. Over 1,500 book reserves were made, demonstrating initiative, independence and critical thinking skills.





STUDENTS LIBRARIANS & HELPERS

We had 29 student librarians volunteer this year. 16 bronze level & 1 silver level library skills training certificates were awarded.

30 year 6 students worked at the Book Fair.

LIBRARY FUN

We had 3 visiting authors. 11 kids went to the Book Battle. 30 kids went to the Auckland Writers Festival. Other library activities included a Poetry Competition, Book Week Competitions, a Book Parade, Toilet Roll Book Characters and a Time Machine!
