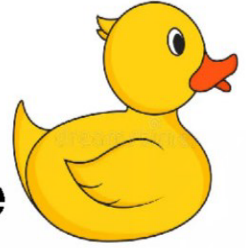

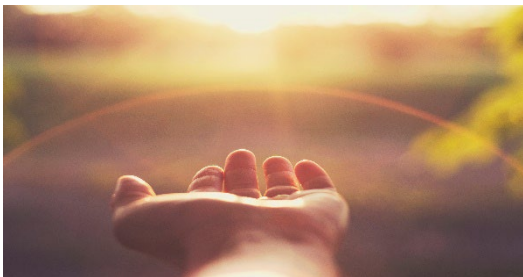

Easter and Anzac Day

Waiau, Rotherham and Culverden - Rubbish, Recycling and Transfer Station Information

There will be no change to the rubbish and recycling collection day in Waiau, Rotherham and Culverden over Easter.

Remember to recycle correctly and only put the following clean items in the recycling bags. Bags containing items which are not accepted, or glass bottles will be stickered and left.

- ✓ Plastic bottles, trays and containers numbered 1, 2 and 5 only (no smaller than 100ml or bigger than 4 litres and no lids)

Good Friday – Friday 18 April
Easter Sunday – Sunday 20 April
Easter Monday – Monday 21 April
Anzac Day – Friday 25 April

In lieu of the above, Amberley transfer station will be open from 10am to 2pm on Tuesday 15 and 22 April.

When using the transfer station, to decrease waiting times, please stagger visits, sort rubbish and recycling and remove lids from glass bottles prior to arrival.

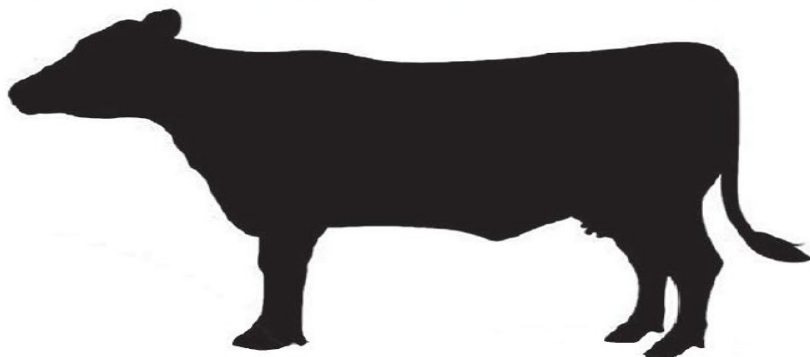
