



UNIFORM REGULATIONS

OPTION A

- **Junior (Year 7-10) students**
monogrammed pinstripe short or long-sleeved shirt, worn tucked in
- **Senior (Year 11-13) students** -
monogrammed white short or long-sleeved shirt, worn tucked in
- Trinity Catholic College tie - when wearing the tie it is expected that the shirt will be tucked in
- Uniform shorts, uniform trousers or Trinity Lavalava / Tupenu
- Monogrammed jersey or vest
- **Junior (Year 7-10) students** -
uniform softshell jacket
- **Senior (Year 11-13) students** -
Trinity Catholic College blazer
- Regulation black socks

OPTION B

- **Junior (Year 7-10) and Senior (Year 11-13) students** monogrammed white short or long-sleeved blouse, worn tucked in
- Trinity Catholic College tie. When wearing the tie, it is expected that the blouse will be tucked in
- Trinity Catholic College kilt, uniform trousers, uniform shorts or Trinity Lavalava / Tupenu
- Monogrammed jersey or vest
- **Junior (Year 7-10) students** - uniform softshell jacket
- **Senior (Year 11-13) students** - Trinity Catholic College blazer
- Regulation white socks that are visible above the ankle, or navy tights



Term 1&4 (Summer) Option:

- Students may choose not to wear the tie and wear a short sleeved shirt untucked
- Long sleeve shirts must remain tucked in

Term 1&4 (Summer) Option:

- Uniform summer skirt
- Students may choose not to wear the tie and wear a short sleeved blouse untucked
- Long sleeve blouses must remain tucked in

Note, Blazers may be worn over the summer uniform option.

Trinity Catholic College Physical Education Uniform (Physical Education uniform top and Physical Education uniform shorts or tights) is required by all Year 7-10 students, and senior students playing in a sports team where uniform isn't supplied.

It is available for purchase from the Otago Sports Depot.

Trinity Catholic College uniform bucket hats, scarves and beanies can be worn and are available for purchase from the school office.

Full school uniform (not a Physical Education uniform) must be worn when travelling to school in the morning.



Footwear:

Shoes are required to be plain, black, heeled, leather, school style shoes.

Sandals are required to be plain, black, leather, school style sandals with a heel strap.

Closed footwear is required for practical subjects.

Hair:

Hair should be of a natural hair colour. Face and eyes must be visible.

Hair longer than the shoulders must be tied back for practical and technology classes.

Students should be clean-shaven.

Jewellery:

One small and plain earring (stud or sleeper)

One plain ring

Religious or culturally significant jewellery is permitted

No other jewellery is allowed – bangles, bracelets, necklaces etc

Nose piercings are to be replaced with a clear plastic version or covered

Makeup / Nail Polish / Eyelash Extensions:

Makeup is not appropriate for school. Any student noticed wearing makeup will be required to remove it.

Nail polish is not permitted and students will be asked to remove it.

Eyelash extensions are not allowed.

Non regulation uniform

Students who arrive at school in non-regulation uniform should have a note from their parent / caregiver explaining that repairs or replacements are underway.



Determining appropriateness

The Principal and Senior Leadership reserve the right to determine if uniform requirements are being met based on the uniform policy. All students are expected to meet the uniform standards.
