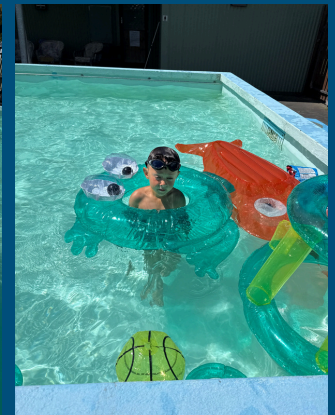
Community News
