CIVIL EMERGENCY		 If a civil emergency strikes in transit, the bus must stop. All children remain with the driver until otherwise directed by the teacher in charge of the trip. Once the event has passed and if the roads are clear, the bus returns the children back to school. If the bus is unable to proceed, the teacher-in-charge is to find safe accommodation for the children and immediately contact the school for further instructions. If children are injured, they are moved to a safe place, teachers provide first aid, and emergency services are called. If a civil emergency strikes at the location, all school personnel must follow the instructions of the organiser. Once the event has finished, the teachers-in-charge will contact the school for further instructions. If safe, the children are transported back to school.
