


### Tēnā koutou

The Kamo High School Parent & Student Portal name and web address have changed. It is now called the **KHS Portal** and is a browser based solution eliminating the need to download any app(s) to access the portal using mobile devices.

### THE KHS PORTAL NEW FEATURES

- Student Timetable and Attendance
- School Notices and the School Calendar can be viewed by the public
- Summary information, Class Efforts (Engagement), Groups and Awards
- Student, Caregiver and Emergency Contact details
- Course Selection (when enabled)
- Absence Notify
- Results both for the current year and for all years
- Progress Reports for the entire time the student has been enrolled at school

#### What's New?

- Caregivers can advise the school when their child will be away from school for the day and specify a reason for the absence.
- Students and caregivers can see which third parties their data is being sent to, and opt out if they wish.
- Significant improvements to security to help keep private information safe.

# Can I continue using the current Web Portal / App?

The current KAMAR Web Portal and app will continue working "as is, where is" until the end of 2024. It will no longer be functional in 2025

# What about the KAMAR mobile apps?

The Android and iPhone apps will no longer work with the new Portal. We've optimised the Web Portal for use on mobile devices, so students and whānau can use the Web Portal on any device with an internet connection.

You can even "save" the Web Portal as a bookmark, making it look and feel just like an app, but without the hassle of updating anything.
