

CONTRACT FOR THE USE OF TITIRANGI SCHOOL SWIMMING POOL 2025/2026 SEASON

If you would like to purchase a key please do so via Kindo

The Titirangi School Board will permit families who are authorised key holders to use the school swimming pool between the hours of 10.00am and 6.00pm on non school days and between 3.30pm and 6.30pm on school days, subject to the following terms and conditions. **Keys are available for collection in the last week of term - 9am**Monday 15th December until 12pm Wednesday 17th December. There will be a safety briefing at the time of key collection.

PLEASE NOTE

- ❖ The Safety of all using the pool is our number 1 priority Key holders must ensure the pool gate is shut whenever entering or leaving the pool enclosure, even if there is someone still using the pool. The gate should never be propped open.
- Child swimmers must be accompanied by and <u>ACTIVELY</u> supervised by a caregiver aged 18 or over. Neither the School Board nor the school shall be expected to supervise or attend the pool.
- ❖ Never swim alone, a caregiver (the caregiver must be 18 years of age or over), <u>MUST</u> accompany and supervise all children. Caregivers with children under 5 MUST accompany the children in the water, when they are swimming.
- ❖ Ensure the gate is securely shut and <u>locked</u> when you leave; a key is required to both enter and exit the pool complex. THIS IS VITALLY IMPORTANT TO PROTECT ALL STUDENTS ON SCHOOL GROUNDS.
 - The pool is closed for maintenance periodically, usually no more than 45 minutes. It is necessary to close the pool during this time to sanitise the pool water to an acceptable standard for school and community use.
- A key charge of \$140.00 is payable to cover some of the costs of the keys, maintaining the pool during the holiday period and after school hours, as well as completing some upgrades to the pool area.
- A \$20 refund will be given to you IF your key is returned by Thursday 2nd April (last day of Term 1). Keys are issued on the understanding that only members of the family residing at the same address will use them and all family members will follow the attached pool user's code. Passing keys to someone who should not be in the pool, i.e. they have not paid for a key, underage (teenagers unsupervised), will result in the key being withdrawn with no refund.
- THE POOL WILL BE OPEN FOR COMMUNITY USE FROM THURSDAY 18th December 2024
- NO DOGS / VAPING / SMOKING is permitted in the pool area or the school grounds.
- The pool area is protected by two surveillance cameras.
- Any unauthorised person who uses the pool is liable to prosecution.
- No one shall themselves, nor shall permit others to damage school property. All persons shall be responsible for any damage caused by them.

- Neither the School Board nor the staff of the school shall be liable or responsible for any death, accident, injury, loss or damage to property arising out of the use of the pool and any person using the pool shall indemnify the School Board and the staff from all claims that may be made against them arising out of the use of the pool and pool area.
- Every endeavour will be made to ensure the quality of the pool water is maintained, but neither the School Board nor the staff of the school shall be liable if the quality falls below the acceptable standard.
- The Principal, any staff member, or member of the School Board, or authorised person, shall have the right to remove any person from the pool area who is breaching these rules, or acting inappropriately. Any school equipment left in the pool area outside of school hours is NOT to be used by pool users.

SWIMMING POOL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Swimming pools can be dangerous. Water always presents a risk of drowning, and injury can be sustained from the hard surfaces associated with the pool and its surrounds, or from the misuse of equipment.
- No dunking or pushing people under water.
- No boogie boards/surf boards in the pool.
- Teenagers (under 18 years of age) are not to use the pool unless part of a family group under parental / caregiver control.
- Never swim while under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Smoking / vaping / alcohol are not permitted in the swimming pool area or the school grounds.
- Avoid holding your breath and swimming long distances underwater.
- Make sure you know how deep the water is. No diving or jumping into the pool.
- Avoid dangerous behaviour, eg: running/walking around the side of the pool and pushing others into the pool.
- Your behaviour should not interfere with the enjoyment of others using the pool. It is the responsibility of
 parents/caregivers to ensure that their children's behaviour is not disturbing to other pool users or the
 school's neighbours.

- Users may use the toilet and changing rooms but please ensure that the toilet is kept tidy and free of rubbish.

ANY ABUSE OF PRIVILEGES OR THESE CONDITIONS WILL LEAVE THE SCHOOL BOARD NO ALTERNATIVE BUT TO DEMAND THE RETURN OF THE KEY FROM THE HOLDER WITHOUT COMPENSATION OR REFUND.
