Code Of Conduct

Horomaka Sport endorses the Fair Play Charter of New Zealand as part of its school sports policy. To ensure Horomaka Sport's reputation is maintained on and off the field all students, coaches, managers, parents & supporters must adhere to the following code of conduct.

'PLAY and EXCEL' Horomaka Sports Code

- To make sport enjoyable and rewarding.
- To compete to the best of our ability with enthusiasm and fairness.
- To respect the rules which govern the game and play by those rules on all occasions.
- To accept and respect the role of the official always and to abide by decisions they make.
- To respect the mana of our opponents and their supporters.
- To value the spirit of fairplay and to accept victory and loss with respect and dignity.

A Horomaka Student/Player will:

- Attend all trials, practices and meetings.
- Arrive at games at the agreed time.
- Play the game competitively, to win within both the spirit and the letter of the rules.
- Accept and conform to all rulings by game officials.
- Refrain from any conduct that in the opinion of the game officials render a player unfit to continue to play the game.
- Be supportive of team members, coaches and officials.
- Wear your school uniforms and colours correctly and with pride.
- Take care of and respect ALL equipment.
- Pay fees by the required date. If there are problems, contact the Sport Director in advance.
- Behave in an acceptable manner demonstrating fair play behaviour at all times in accordance with this Horomaka Sport Code of Conduct and our school values.
- Min 80% attendance aiming for above 90%

A Horomaka Coach will:

- Be a role model so as to inspire confidence.
- Be reasonable in their demands on players.
- Enhance and encourage the skill and performance of their team.
- Praise and encourage good performance.
- Be respectful of their team and opposition's ability as players.
- Be firm and fair.
- Encourage adherence to this Horomaka Sport Code of Conduct and our school values.

A Horomaka Manager will:

- Be a role model to inspire confidence.
- Be responsible for sound management and well-being for the good of their team.
- Encourage the wearing of team uniforms correctly at all times.
- Be supportive of Players, Officials and Supporters.

Encourage adherence to the Horomaka Sport Code of Conduct and our school values.

A Horomaka Supporter will:

- Encourage all participants to play within the rules of the game.
- Applaud the performance of **both** teams.
- Be positive with the officials & acknowledge their efforts.
- Let the players play their game, not your game.
- Praise efforts, not results.
- Display self-control on the side-line & set an example for the players.
- Use appropriate and acceptable language.
- Remember that nearly all coaches/officials and administrators are volunteers.
- **Students, managers** and **coaches** need to sign a contract about these expectations.
- These forms are issued by the Sports Coordinator (a separate form is available) along with the police vetting information for outside coaches.

Middle School Swimming Sports

Top swimmers from the day will be selected to compete at Canterbury School Champs.

Athletics Sports

Athletics is held in Term 1 (27th Feb) over one day at Nga Puna Wai Sports Hub. Students are expected to meet at the stadium and are expected to make their own way home. Students are encouraged to participate. Registrations will be online, these forms will be available during Whanau times. Top Athletes from the day will be selected to compete at Canterbury School Champs.

Cross Country

The School Cross Country is held during Term 2 (16th May) over half a day at Hoon Hay Park. This event is for participants only. Students will meet in their Whanau groups and will walk over to the park. The course is a 3km loop. Sign up forms will be emailed to all students and will also be available during whanau times. Top athletes from the day will be selected to compete at the Canterbury Schools Road Race and Cross Country Champs.

Whanau Competitions

During the year we have Whanau house competitions such as Korfball, Volleyball, Football, Multi Sport etc. These competitions are held during Whanau time, first break and second break. Competitions are broken into two grades, middle School and Senior School. Sign up for teams are organised by the Whanau leaders during Whanau time. Dates and draws will be announced on School notices and social media.

Sports Uniform

All uniforms are to be issued through the Sports Office. Any new items need to be approved by the Horomaka Sports Committee. There will be no exceptions to this, no mufti is to be worn by team members representing Hillmorton. **No uniform No play**.

It is students responsibility to take care of the uniforms that's provided by the sports office and return them at the end of the season. Students failing to return their uniforms will be invoiced for the cost of replacement.

Sponsorship on apparel: any sponsors outside the existing sponsors need to be granted by the Sports Committee.

Horomaka Sports Merch

Currently Horomaka sports are working on brand new Sports merch with our new School colours and design. These will be ready for the Winter season. Keep an eye out for the new Sports merch!

Sports Levy: Each student is charged **\$10** levy to cover the expenses of facility management. <u>This Fee will ONLY be charged once NOT per Sport.</u>

The sports coordinator will set up team lists and notify the student office of the charge that needs to be made against this list. Please check with the Sports Coordinator of the cost for the activity. The school has a policy of **NO PAY, NO PLAY**. Therefore, cut off dates will be issued at the beginning of each season.

Teachers in charge of codes need to ensure that your fees are up to date on the registration forms and on the website (Sports Coordinator to assist).

Any budget requests need to be put through to the Sports Director.

All students going on trips throughout the course of the year must have paid the amount before going. For example South Island, National and International (must be self-funded) travel.

Hardship Funding: See the principal or Sports Director if members of your team are unable to pay to play.

Funding for gear, students or trips

Application for Grant Funding from Trusts and Foundations: Proposals for these must come through the Horomaka Sport Committee, these are then passed onto the EO (Executive Officer). They must be lodged at the beginning of each year. In addition to these two quotes must be arranged.

Sponsorship

All current and potential sponsorship must be coordinated through the Director of Sport. Currently, we have Gold and Silver 3-year sponsorship packages.

Applications for these funds need to be submitted to the Director of Sport and the decision is made by the Horomaka Sport Committee.
