Nippers Programme for children under 14 years old

The St Kilda Nippers Programme aims to create a fun, enjoyable, positive and safe atmosphere, while developing the children's confidence in the surf and developing their water safety knowledge. This is achieved through beach education, board training and pool sessions at Moana swimming pool.

The Saturday Summer Beach Education sessions are held November to April at St Kilda Beach from 2:00-3:00pm. With the help of lifeguards and parents the Nippers work on basic ocean safety, learning their limits and how to read the beach and ocean. We also develop the skills required for future lifeguarding through use of the NZSLS sports disciplines of beach flags, sand sprints, relays, and ocean based events of swimming and board training.
