# Why are fees changing?

ORC is updating fares to meet **new central government funding rules.**

## What's changing

### Child (5–12 years)

- Free fare for children aged 5–12 will end
- New fare will be \$1.50 with a Bee Card\*, or \$3 with cash

### Youth (13–18 years)

- New fare will be \$1.50 with a Bee Card\*

### Adult (19+ years)

- New fare will be \$2.50 with a Bee Card\*

### SuperGold card holder (65+ years)

- New peak-time fare will be \$2.50 with a Bee Card\*

### Community Connect

- New fare will be \$1.25 with a Bee Card\*

\*If your Bee Card is not registered, you will be charged the Adult Bee Card fare amount

## What's staying the same

- Children under 5 years will remain free  
— no Bee Card needed
- The cash fare will remain \$3
- SuperGold off-peak hours and free fares will remain the same
