There is a maximum 384 Half Days or 192 Full Days for High Schools that buses can run. This is different for St Andrews, Beaconsfield and the other ASTN Primary Schools.

# Following input from all ASTN schools the ASTN buses will run to coincide with the following School Terms for 2025

#### Term 1

Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> January to Friday 11th April - less Waitangi Day, = (104/52)

#### Term 2

Monday 28th April to 27<sup>th</sup> June - less Kings Birthday & Matariki = (86/43)

#### Term 3

Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July to Friday 19<sup>th</sup> September = (100/50)

#### Term 4

Monday 6th October to - Wednesday 10th December less Labour Day = (94/47)

(Any days in excess of 192 will be funded by ASTN.)

### **Total School Days 384/192**

Buses will run for the Primary Schools as required.

#### **Notes**

- All buses run to the same daily timetable every day of the above schedule and cannot be changed to suit individual schools. The only variation is when all teachers from all Timaru secondary schools have a paid stop work meeting, when the morning or afternoon arrival or departure times may be changed by the Bus Controller.
- The drivers are willing to deliver and pick up students as they pass the SBS Sports Stadium on Morgans road, when each school has its Sports Day or similar at that venue. Schools should arrange this directly with each driver via duty teachers or senior bus students. It is not necessary to inform the Bus Controller.
- 3 Bus routes and times cannot be changed to accommodate individual school events such as swimming or athletics sports.
