Easter and ANZAC Refuse and Recycling Arrangements

Refuse and recycling collection days in Culverden, Rotherham and Waiau will not be changing over EASTER and ANZAC, with collections running as normal on a Thursday.

- Only Hurunui Council bags will be collected, these are available from various outlets in Hurunui.
- Bags must be securely tied and at the kerbside or council collection point by 8am. Collection times may vary to normal, and the crew will not return to collect bags placed out late.
- Refuse bags must not exceed 15kg in weight. Bags split prior to the crew's arrival and non-official bags will not be collected.
- Bundles of cardboard will not be collected but can be recycled via any transfer station.

What is accepted via the recycling collections if clean and loose in a Council recycling bag?

- Newspapers, magazines, office paper and telephone directories.
- Cardboard, greetings cards, junk mail, envelopes, and egg boxes.
- Food, drink, and pet food cans.
- Rigid plastic bottles and small containers, types 1, 2 and 5 with lids removed.

What cannot be recycled?

Soft plastics, plastics 3, 4, 6 and 7, tetrapaks, polystyrene (including meat trays), plant pots, plastic strapping, clothing, food-stained paper or card, coffee cups, plastic lids, foil trays and food waste are not recyclable - if in doubt throw it out.

Do not put glass bottles in recycling bags, these can be recycled via any transfer station.





Flu Vaccines

Flu season is upon us, and flu vaccines are available now. Please ring reception to arrange an appointment.

Vaccines are fully funded:

- You are 65 years and over
- You are pregnant
- Adults and Children who have a chronic health condition
- Māori and Pacific peoples aged 55 to 64 years

Non-funded vaccines cost **\$25** for registered adults and children.

Non-funded vaccines cost **\$36** for non-registered patients.

Remember, Immunisation is the best way to protect our communities and Whanau from infection and serious illness.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, lockdown periods and border closures, influenza infections for the past two years have been very low which may have led to lower immunity in the NZ population.

As COVID-19 restrictions ease and borders re-open, it can be expected that a resurgence of respiratory viruses will follow, and vaccination against the Influenza virus is highly recommended.
