

- \* Pictures must be ready to hang in the gallery, where they will remain for two months (August & September).

  \*\*note: Please ensure your hanging system is robust so that the work will not fall off the wall.
- \* A maximum of **two pieces** may be entered but only one award will be made to the same person for 1st, 2nd,
- \*Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, 3rd.
  - Age groups 5 7 years and 8 11 years will receive art products from The Drawing Room Age groups 12 14 and 15 18 and Adults will receive vouchers from The Drawing Room
