ACADEMIC

Fairfield Intermediate School provides a dynamic, evolving curriculum which focuses on all aspects of the New Zealand Curriculum to cater for the needs of young adolescents. While we have a strong emphasis on literacy and mathematics, we are committed to academic excellence through an integrated curriculum. Students are encouraged to be innovative, work collaboratively and to develop skills in the key competencies of thinking, using languages, symbols and text, managing self, relating to others and participating and contributing. While students attend specialist classes, they are predominantly based in their homeroom with one teacher, allowing strong learning relationships to form and a truly integrated learning approach.

Fairfield Intermediate School is a BYOD School. This means that students are able to bring their own digital device to support and enhance their learning. We also offer two accelerate learning classes which cater for students operating at a high academic level.
