## Swim 300m (U14, U16) 400m (U19)

All age categories start on the beach of beautiful Glendhu Bay before heading into crystal-clear waters for a 300m or 400m swim returning to the beach front before heading to transition.

Bike 10km (U14, U16) 20km (U19)
Picking up your bike in transition you'll head out on the scenic 10km loop toward Treble Cone for either 1 or 2 laps depending on your age category.



## Run 3.5km (U14, U16) 4km (U19)

Once you've racked your bike it's time to run the final leg of your race down the Motatapu Road before circling back to your victory sprint through the finish chute at Glendhu Station!

Be a part of the world renowned Challenge Wanaka Festival of Triathlon in its brand new location at Glendhu Bay and kick-start events with our Secondary Schools race. Individuals & teams will swim, bike and run to complete the course on Thursday 18th February. All competitors will receive a medal and t-shirt upon finishing plus a special Challenge Family gift. We will also be crowning the Otago Secondary Schools Champions as a part of this event, with the results being separated out from the overall Secondary Schools Race.

Entry costs \$10 per person for Otago, Southland & Aoraki Secondary Schools for individual or team - entries through the sports coordinator. All other regional schools \$30 individual and \$60 per team online registration. Entries open online 24 January 2021.
