All projects must have an arts focus, begin after 28 September 2022 and be completed before 28 September 2023.

There are three funding criteria under the Creative Communities Fund –

Access and Participation - performances by community choirs, hip-hop groups, theatre companies or poets; workshops on painting, sketching, printmaking, writing or dancing etc; exhibitions by local craft groups, festivals featuring local artists; creation of a film or public artwork; development of new tukutuku whakairo or kowhaiwhai for a local marae; artist residencies involving local artists or communities; seminars for the development of local artists.

<u>Diversity</u> - workshops, rehearsals, performances, festivals or exhibitions in Maori or Pasifika heritage or contemporary artforms or by local migrant communities; arts projects that bring together groups from a range of different communities; workshops, rehearsals, performances, festivals or exhibitions by groups with experience of disability or mental illness.

<u>Young people</u> – young people to engage with and actively participate in working with an artist to create a mural or street art; creating a film about an issue that's important to them; publication of a collection of writings by young people; music workshops for young people; an exhibition of visual art by young people.

Registering at the Health Centre

If you reside within our community or would like Amuri Health Centre to be your main place for health care, we encourage you to enrol with us. You will receive subsidised health care, be eligible for funded services and receive seamless care by doing so.

As per Ministry of Health guidelines patients may only enrol at one Health Centre.

Although we can provide care to patients who are not enrolled with us, their visits will incur increased charges as we do not receive any funding to subsidise these.

If you are a non-New Zealander on a work visa, you may still be able to enrol. Please contact reception to check if you are eligible.

World Hepatitis Day – Stick it to Hep C



The new campaign launched last week to raise awareness of Hepatitis C, an infection of the liver spread via blood-to-blood contact.

Many people don't know they have Hep C because the symptoms aren't always visible even though it can lead to serious liver disease.

The good news is that testing for Hep C is easy – just a finger prick – and it can be cured in just eight weeks for most people, once it's been identified. The treatment is fully subsidised, so it's also free with a prescription.
