There are three funding criteria under the Creative Communities Fund –

**Access and Participation** - performances by community choirs, hip-hop groups, theatre companies or poets; workshops on painting, sketching, printmaking, writing or dancing etc; exhibitions by local craft groups, festivals featuring local artists; creation of a film or public artwork; development of new tukutuku whakairo or kowhaiwhai for a local marae; artist residencies involving local artists or communities; seminars for the development of local artists.

**Diversity** - workshops, rehearsals, performances, festivals or exhibitions in Maori or Pasifika heritage or contemporary artforms or by local migrant communities; arts projects that bring together groups from a range of different communities; workshops, rehearsals, performances, festivals or exhibitions by groups with experience of disability or mental illness.

**Young people** – young people to engage with and actively participate in working with an artist to create a mural or street art; creating a film about an issue that's important to them; publication of a collection of writings by young people; music workshops for young people; an exhibition of visual art by young people.

The good news is that testing for Hep C is easy – just a finger prick – and it can be cured in just eight weeks for most people, once it's been identified. The treatment is fully subsidised, so it's also free with a prescription.

## HOW TO APPLY TO THE YAMHA FLEXI FUND

### PURPOSE

To reduce barriers that prevent 13-18-year-olds affected by mild to moderate mental health or alcohol /addiction issues from accessing necessary services by providing interventions to improve their wellbeing.

### APPLICANTS

Members of YAMHA are eligible to apply to the FlexiFund on behalf of their clients. The clients must be eligible for publicly funded health services in New Zealand.

### APPLICATIONS

- must relate to a specific one-off purchase
- must be for funding which is unavailable elsewhere (e.g. family, WINZ)
- may relate to the provision of group work for eligible clients
- funding for individual clients has a recommended cap of \$500 +gst
- must include evidence for the amount requested

### SUBMITTING AN APPLICATION

- **Email completed applications to:** [flexifund@odysseychch.org.nz](mailto:flexifund@odysseychch.org.nz)
- incomplete applications will not be considered
- decisions of the CYMHS Clinical Coordinator are final
- it is the responsibility of the applicant to implement the intervention for their client
- payments are made either to the retailer or to the applicant (not to the client) upon presentation of a valid tax invoice or receipt
- all flexifund payments must be complete within 3 months of the approval date
- the applicant is requested to provide a brief narrative of how the funding benefitted their client
