



## Tractor Attestation/Log

For people to be assessed as competent in driving a tractor with an attached implement (including attaching and detaching the implement), it is necessary that they have or achieve 10 hours of driving to be awarded the practical unit standards. This gives the tutor(s) who is assessing them some confidence that the skills, ability and attitude they are seeing on the day, are likely to be repeatable in the future.

If a student has prior experience they can use that to contribute up to half of the required 10 hours and log the remaining hours following their initial training day.
